Registration Information

Registration will start at 12 Noon on Sunday. Look for us at our table in the convention center.

Payment for all classes is expected when you register your child. No spaces can be held without full payment. We accept cash, credit/debit cards, or checks payable to GAE4-HA.

Minimum age to participate is **8** years old. Youth younger than 8 years old may participate if accompanied by an adult or older sibling and dependent on class.

GAE4-HA Extension Agents will meet you and your child at the Convention Center for all activities. Look for adults in GAE4-HA shirts holding signs with the name of your child's class. We will return your child to the same location at the time posted. Please make sure to check your child out. We will not leave until you have picked up your child.

Adults will be stationed out front and around the inside of Summer Waves Water Park. Youth will be required to wear a provided armband. They will be able to walk around with friends or on their own inside the park. Younger children should be accompanied by an adult or older sibling.

Shoes or sandals with heel straps are required to most classes.

University of Georgia regulations requires a medical release form for each **child**.

A GAEL waiver form is required for each **family**.

A Tidelands waiver form is required for each **person** (child and/or adult) for kayaking.

*A health screening form will also be required this year for each **participant**.

***COVID-19 Updates**

Oceans of Fun will follow COVID-19 safety procedures and guidelines provided by Georgia 4-H, the University of Georgia, the CDC, the Georgia Department of Public Health, and the Governor Kemp's 32 requirements for day camps found in recent Executive Orders in partnership with GAEL.
